

COVID-19 UPDATE

12-1-2020 – Positive Staff Person

Dear Residents and Family Members:

We were notified yesterday, 11/30, that a staff member tested positive for COVID-19. In accordance with NYS DOH guidelines, the asymptomatic employee was made aware and was instructed to quarantine at home for 14 days. The NYS and the Dutchess County DOH have also been notified, and the facility will be conducting contact tracing to identify any staff or residents who might have been exposed to the HCP during the incubation period.

As discussed in previous updates and reinforced by the Governor this week, we expect the virus to continue to spread as winter approaches. Unlike other facilities in our region, we are so fortunate that LCC has managed to avoid a COVID outbreak, and we are cautiously optimistic that we will continue to have only isolated, asymptomatic staff and/or resident cases.

Please help us achieve this goal by avoiding or limiting social gatherings, maintaining physical distance, wearing a mask and getting tested. Be safe and stay strong.
