

December 8, 2025 – Flu Outbreak

Dear Residents and Family Members,

It has been some time since we have had to make you aware of Flu positive cases. On Thursday, 12/4/25 one of our residents on long term unit 2 South was sent out to the hospital and was admitted with Flu A. We then tested the exposed residents on unit 2 South on 12/4/2025 and they were negative. We had one resident tested positive for flu on unit One North and three on unit 2 South over the past weekend. All residents are treated with Tamiflu and are on isolation.

Our RN Infection Control Preventionist notified NYSDOH, and we are following the most current guidelines recommended.

We have posted signage in the front lobby notifying visitors of the outbreak

Unit 2 South is closed and closely monitoring other units. Activities and communal dining are limited to these units. Visiting is not restricted, however you are encouraged to wear a mask and practice frequent hand washing at a minimum before and after your visit.
