9-1-2022—Positive Staff

Dear Residents and Family Members:

LCC identified one staff person that tested positive for Covid-19 yesterday, and that individual is currently isolating at home. The facility will do contact tracing and test any individuals that we determine may have been exposed. Positive results will be reported to the New York State and Dutchess County Departments of Health, as necessary.

Other than the morning entertainment planned for Labor Day in the living room, you should take advantage of the beautiful weather and conduct your visits outdoors. Isolated cases amongst residents and staff will continue to occur indefinitely, so outdoor visitation minimizes risk of transmission. A securely-fitted mask is necessary at all times while in the building. If you are feeling ill or have recently been exposed to someone that is sick, you should postpone your visit and get tested. If you need to isolate, Carolyn and her staff can enable you to stay connected to your loved one using our virtual visitation technology.
