Following our last update on Friday, we had one staff person test positive for Covid-19 late that afternoon. The staff person was instructed to isolate at home for the required time period, and the results were reported to the local and state Departments of Health. Contact tracing testing identified no additional cases, currently.

As the weather cools off, respiratory illnesses season is heating up! The nursing staff is in the process of collecting resident and family consent forms and plans to commence administering influenza vaccines next week. We anticipate following that up with a Covid booster clinic for residents, and then staff will be next!

If you are planning to visit us, please use our outdoor areas whenever possible. If you must postpone visiting due to illness, Carolyn and her staff can assist you with virtual visitation, so you don't miss a beat! We will use our best efforts to keep your loved ones up to date with vaccines, but don't forget to schedule appointments for yourself!
