

COVID-19 UPDATES

8-12-2022—COVID Positive Residents

Dear Residents and Family Members:

For the last few days, we have been reporting on several isolated cases of covid positive staff and residents. The Dutchess County transmission level stands at “medium” currently, so our experience is in line with the rest of the County. As a result of contact tracing, on 8/11 and 8/12 we identified five (5) new residents testing positive for Covid. The NYS and local Departments of Health have been notified, and we are relieved that these residents are experiencing only minor symptoms, if any.

In an effort to contain transmission, we have cohorted positive residents in a designated hallway and initiated a 10-day quarantine for roommates of those residents. The facility remains open for visitation, but as I stressed yesterday, you must wear a mask whenever you are in the building and must present with a negative covid test, prior to access to the residents. More than 2 visitors per resident should meet in the lobby or, preferably outside on the patio. If you have been exposed, are feeling unwell, or choose not to visit the facility currently, please contact Carolyn and her team for help facilitating a virtual visit.
