

COVID-19 UPDATE

6-9-2022—Positive Staff

Dear Residents and Family Members:

I'll start today's update with the good news that Spectrum, our cable, internet, and phone service provider, completed their scheduled maintenance yesterday, and service was restored much sooner than anticipated.

Covid testing identified one positive staff person on 6/8. That staff person will be isolating at home as required, and the result was reported to the New York State and Dutchess County Departments of Health.

A reminder that there are no visitation restrictions, but now that the weather is cooperating so nicely, we recommend visiting outdoors. You should have a securely-fitted mask on at all times while in the building and physical distance from other residents and visitors whenever possible. Anyone feeling sick, or anyone recently been exposed to someone that is sick should postpone your visit and get tested. Our virtual visitation will facilitate your remaining connected to your loved until you have completed your isolation period. Contact Carolyn if you or your resident need technical assistance.
