

## **COVID-19 Update**

**6-18-2020**

To Our Residents and Family Members:

As required, this update is being provided to you today due to several recent changes.

We have intensified our infection control precautions throughout the facility, and we are vigorously testing all our staff weekly. As you may expect, that level of testing will reveal some positive cases.

We have identified four staff members testing positive in the last two days. None of the four were exhibiting any symptoms of the virus, but all were informed of the results and instructed to seek medical care and isolate at home for the required 14-day period. In addition to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the NYS and the Dutchess County Department of Health were immediately notified. Our Medical Director has been consulted and believes these isolated cases present minimal risk to your loved ones. No new resident cases have been confirmed, and we have not identified any patterns by shift or units worked for the staff members.

Our regular COVID-19 Update will be provided at the end of the week, per usual. Contact your Unit Manager, Social Worker, or the Director of Nursing for resident clinical updates, and/or for any resident concerns you may have as they arise.
